Renal Cell Carcinoma and Penile Prosthesis Placement

List of Selection Criteria


- ✓ Video submitted describes a gold standard in the management of:
 - **Renal cell carcinoma**. More especially, video submitted *describes the standard steps of a typical* laparoscopic radical nephrectomy or a robotic radical nephrectomy.
 - **Penile prosthesis placement**. Specifically, the video submitted should describe *the standard steps of a typical* malleable penile prosthesis or an inflatable penile prosthesis procedure.
- Proof that permission was granted to use any patient images, music, or anything else that requires copyrights permission
- ✓ All patient information is removed from the video
- ✓ Make sure that the patient's face is blurred or that there is a black square over the eyes
- ✓ Video length is <u>between 5 and 8 min</u>
- ✓ Video has a comprehensive/creative title
- Video does not contain any commercial bias
- Mandatory: voice over and subtitles are clear and easy to understand (in English)
 - > Any indications mentioned need to be based on available international guidelines and clinical characteristics
 - > It would be important to indicate/narrate the key steps of the procedure
 - > The use of pointer animation, arrows, etc. to identify anatomical landmarks is recommended
 - > Only generic name of drugs are to be used
- ✓ Author provided outline slides (maximum 4 slides) containing:
 - > Author's name, credentials and affiliations
 - Disclosure of any conflicts of interest
 - Case summary (including clear background information about the patient, the technique presented and the challenges you have faced)

It is the responsibility of the author to ensure that there are no errors in the material submitted and that all outline slides and the video submitted are properly formatted.

Accepted Video Format

Accepted video format (preferably recorded in HD format):

- ✓ MP4 (preferred format), MOV, AVI, MKV
- ✓ Minimum resolution of 1280x720 (16:9) or 960x740 (4:3) and 1080 height maximum
- ✓ Pixel ratio 1:1
- ✓ Compression rate should never be lower than "4000k per second" resolution file
- ✓ The video sent must not contain pixels
- ✓ The video sent is no longer than 8 minutes
