OVERVIEW

Modern methods for prostate cancer detection yield significantly higher detection rates than conventional methods. The NICE guidance for Prostate Cancer asks to implement the use of mpMRI for lesion detection at several points of the diagnostic pathway. Radiologists and Urologists need to be aware of the implications for their practice.

The original course package has been developed by Professor Schlemmer and extended by the Cambridge-based organisers. It has been used successfully for numerous courses in Europe, Asia, in a 1-day course on the FT2015 and 2017 and each year since 2013 in Cambridge with unanimous applause.

This international multi-disciplinary workshop is intended for Radiologists and Urologists with a keen interest in high-level prostate cancer detection methods. They will acquire advanced knowledge and practical skills to detect potentially malignant prostate lesions in multiparametric MR image sets according to the ESUR guidelines.

One of three sessions will be dedicated to advanced reading skills on cases in post-treatment or active surveillance settings.

There is also an opportunity to learn about advanced targeted and image-guided biopsy techniques, including MRI-TRUS fusion (machines to be confirmed).

The interdisciplinary aspects are addressed in talks by invited speakers and discussions.
